Dell Children's TCHAT is a telemedicine program that got me connected with a therapist and psychiatrist my freshman year. My school was already part of the program and with one referral from my counselor, I was able to get the help I needed without expenses. I was diagnosed with anxiety, depression and PTSD, these disorders had been very strenuous before I joined TCHAT and gave me the skillset I still used to manage my mental health.

Along with using TCHAT as a resource, mental health awareness through projects at our student council have improved the overall environment at Hays HS. StuCo created themes around Valentine's Day, while also advocating for mental health and self esteem with positive affirmations put on sticky notes. We also made hearts with every student's name and decorated the main hall with them. We put up clothespins with motivational and inspirational sayings on them for students that need them to take, and pass around to other students lifting up students and spreading positivity. All excellent steps to building an inclusive and safe culture at this campus. I know as the TASC State Parliamentarian I can become better equipped and have the resources to lead this project at the State level, to have the impact it most definitely deserves.
