Description: Each committee was assigned a topic (drugs, alcohol, racism, tobacco, strangers) to write a skit about. The officers were assigned the introduction. The skits had to teach the 2nd graders to say "no" to the topic and each skit has to be themed. Then, emails were sent out to the head teachers for the 2nd grade classes inviting them to participate. Next coloring books with color pages and activities among other things. During the time prior to the performances, we practiced the skits and rented costumes. After the actual performances, we took the kids to the Gym to eat lunch and watch the basketball team practice. Members from National Honor Society, Cheerleaders, Drill Team, and athletes helped escort the kids around the building.
