DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT/ACTIVITY: In working with the counseling department and our service learning class (Food Pantry), student council asks the entire MMS students and staff to start bring in their non-perishable item. Our food drive goes from October 1 – 31, in conjunction with red ribbon week. The team that collects the most non-perishable item for the month is given a pizza, cake, ice cream, soft drink, candy and movie social after their lunch. The twist here is that the winner in each grade level with the most items are given the opportunity to display all their items by way of creating a super hero figure with all food items. Last year was our first year and over 10,000 food items were collected. This year, over 12,000 food items were collected and the 8th grade team created the Pac Man Hero and students got to view their display through channel one. Our plans for next year will be to invite our elementary feeders school to do the same. All our collected food items were donated to our Memorial Middle School Food Pantry, which serves about 600 families per year.
