Objective: To allow the seniors to reserve and paint a parking spot in the senior parking lot

Target Group: High School Senior Drivers

Step by Step: We made a large map of the senior parking lot and numbered each parking spot, then allowed seniors to sign up in pencil for a slot during registration. Each student payed \$50 to reserve a spot that would be thiers during the school day. When students signed up we gave them a list of designated painting days during which they could come and paint their slot with outdoor house paint while student council members supervised to ensure that nothing obscene was painted and only approved paint was used. We raised over \$7500 which we split among various projects and other school organizations. During the year, we used a tow service that would remove a car if it was parked in a reserved spot.
