



## **Good afternoon!**

Thank you for registering for the TASC High School Annual Conference. We are looking forward to an exciting event. We will close registration when we pass 4900 registrants.

## **FAQ's:**

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### **Q: May I just take my check to State?**

A: You may. If you need to pay onsite, plan to do this at the onsite table. The pre-reg table is only for those who have paid in advance. If you need to pay for registration or purchase additional Six Flags tickets on site, be prepared to stand in line in for a short while. We apologize for that. If possible, please mail payment so that it arrives by April 1, 2022, or pay by credit card.

### **Q: Do I really need to submit names, or may I just get name badges printed onsite?**

A: For security reasons, every person at the conference must have a printed name badge. Printing badges at the conference will be time consuming and will probably involve a wait. Please submit names no later than April 1, 2022.

### **Q: May I cancel one of my registrations?**

A: Per TASC Board policy, no cancellations are allowed after the Early Bird Deadline. You may substitute someone. For additional information see the TASC Board policy regarding cancellation, refunds, etc., and the TASC policy re COVID.

### **Q: I have questions about my hotel reservations? Can you help?**

A: Contact the TASC Housing Bureau for those questions. See their contact under Hotel Reservations.

### **Q: I have questions about parking.**

A: There is no bus parking at the Convention Center or at the Westin. They do have parking for vans. More information regarding bus parking is included in information for hotels. There is a drop off site just in front of the Convention Center.

B. Parking for cars, vans, etc. is available at the Westin and the Convention Center for \$5.00 per day with in and out privileges.

### **Q: I need my exact bill for housing early so I can request a check or credit card payment.**

A: Be sure to let the housing bureau know if you need your exact payment amount in advance. Tell them specifically when you will need it.

### **Q: May I change shirt sizes?**

A: Shirt orders will be submitted Monday, March 21 at 8:00 am. We cannot change sizes or numbers after that.

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**Q: May I order extra shirts and Six Flags tickets?**

A: We can take orders for additional shirts through Friday, March 21. Prices are as follows:

S – L = \$12      XL = \$13      XXL = \$14      XXXL and XXXXL = \$16    See the form on the website.

Six Flags tickets may be purchased in advance or onsite for \$50. See the form on the website.

**Q: What time are meetings for flags, table talks, etc.?**

A: The Schedule at a Glance is posted on the website. Those meeting times are listed. Specific committee meetings, times for Table Talk Presenters, JC's for Summer 2022, and District Flag practice will be added later. Table Talk presenters, District Flag Representatives, and 2021 JCs will meet Sunday afternoon. Summer 2022 JCs will meet Monday afternoon during the breakouts.

**Q: May I get discounted tickets for a Rangers game or other nearby venues?**

A: Information regarding Rangers tickets, AT&T Stadium tours, etc. are listed on the website when available. As of Jan. 20, they are not contracted.

**Q: May I order meals from the Convention Center?**

A: A limited number of meals are planned for advance purchase only for dinner Day One and lunch Day Two. See the website for the order form. No outside food may be taken into the Convention Center or to Convention Center outside decks. Note that there is only an hour and 15 minutes allowed for lunch on Day 2. Life will be less hectic if your students eat at the Convention Center.

**Q: Will we have a mobile app for the conference?**

A: Yes, information about downloading the app will be sent prior to the conference. The app will have a gamification element, and prizes may be won through points earned by visiting exhibitors, campaign booths, and special sessions.

**Q. What if we are late to a session?**

A. Being on time to sessions is extremely important as those entering late are a disruption. General sessions have few empty seats, and your group most likely will not be able to sit together. Late arrival to a general session may result in your group's being asked to remain in the lobby until a convenient time in the program. Late arrival to a breakout may result in your group's being asked to remain in the lobby until the next rotation.
