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Montgomery High School has served as a TASC District Officer in District 7 for the last three years, serving as Treasurer for two years and now President-Elect where we will fulfill the Presidency beginning in 2020. In this role, we will host our D7 Spring and Fall Conferences in 2020. This is the first year for MHS to join the National Association of Student Council in which we plan to be active members. Our Student Council received the Conroe YMCA's Rising Star Award in 2017—the first time this award was given to an organization rather than an individual—for planning and implementing a service project that provided YMCA summer sports scholarships to youth in our community who needed financial assistance. Our council was recently selected to present a TASC Student Voices session on our implementation of the Captains & Presidents Club luncheons and the impact they have had on our campus.

This is the fourth year for Mrs. Zuehlke to be in the lead StuCo Advisor position at MHS. In that time she has been selected as the TASC District 7 Advisor of the Year in 2017 and 2020. She was the MHS Teacher of the Year and MISD Secondary Teacher of the Year in 2017. Prior to coming to MHS, she was a co-advisor at East View High School in Georgetown, Texas. Mrs. Zuehlke has a M.Ed. in Instructional Technology and she is currently training to be a TASC Leadership Consultant.

Reid Turner is a Junior at MHS. This is Reid's third year in StuCo and third year as an officer, serving as the Class President his Freshman year, StuCo Public Relations Officer his Sophomore year and now as President-Elect of Student Council where he will serve as President in 2020-2021. Reid will also serve as President of TASC District 7 for the 2020-2021 school year. He has also been selected to be a JC at Summer Leadership Workshop Southwestern #1 this Summer. Reid is a student athlete, he plays left guard on the Varsity football team and is on the Varsity Track and Field team. Due to his academic success, Reid is also a member of Mu Alpha Theta and the National Honor Society.
