Dear Texas Association of Student Councils,



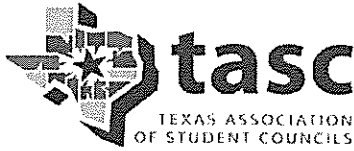
