During the TASC Conference, attendees will have the opportunity to participate in the We Help Two "Socks for Legs" program, in conjunction with Killeen High School, to help provide legs to amputees around the world and warm socks for those in need in Texas.

Over the past 3 years, We Help Two has partnered with schools to provide over 500 legs to amputees who could not afford one. The goal during the TASC Conference is to provide at least 5 legs through the sale of these funky and colorful socks. For every 100 packs of funky socks sold, a prosthetic limb will be gifted to someone in need.

Socks are also one of the most-needed items by the homeless because they are very rarely donated. For every 3-pair pack of funky socks sold during the conference, a warm pair will be donated.

This campaign gives everyone the chance to have a global impact by changing an amputee's life, and a local impact by providing new, warm socks to those in need.
