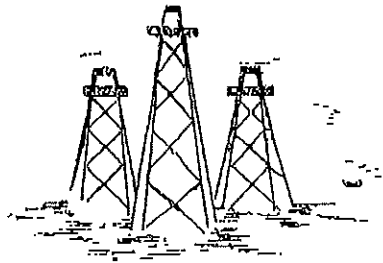

We run a sock drive every October in our high school and our community to collect socks for the homeless.

2007-Present Can Food Drive

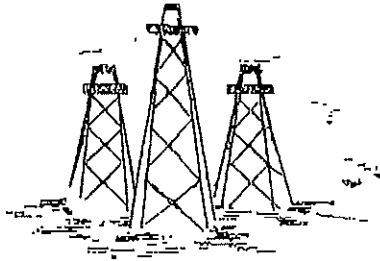
