Board of Directors Policy Regarding Endorsements and/or Partnerships

Programs/projects that complement the mission and purpose of student council may be considered by the Board for an endorsement/partnership. Programs or projects interested in forming a partnership with TASC must demonstrate in writing the ways in which the program enhances the work of or provides a resource to student councils. Programs/projects sponsored by member schools are preferred. The Board will approve this type of relationship at the summer board meeting. The board may determine to limit the number of endorsed programs. These relationships benefit TASC member schools directly, either by providing a resource to the council or to individual students. Endorsed programs often exhibit at TASC events and present at TASC events. Benefits to an endorsed program/partner may include access to member schools data for marketing, inclusion in conferences through presentations and reduced exhibit rates, a link on the TASC website, and inclusion in the TASC Resource Guide. Relationships are established by a board vote and are renewed annually. Existing programs must demonstrate participation by and benefit to schools and justify the continuation of the relationship in writing.

Mission/Purpose of Organization	At SAFE 2 SAVE, we believe one life lost due to distracted driving is one too many. SAFE 2 SAVE is a free mobile app rewarding users for driving undistracted and encouraging accountability to loved ones. Points accrued when traveling undistracted, at least 10 mph, can be redeemed for discounts + free items at restaurants + local businesses. SAFE 2 SAVE is proving to change distracted driving behavior patterns - as one life lost due to distracted driving is one too many.

SAFE 2 SAVE competitions encourage student leaders to drive change in their communities. We encourage students to "level up their leadership" on the road during every competition we host.
Describe in detail the process for TASC member school participation in this program.	One of the unique capabilities SAFE 2 SAVE offers is hosting safe driving competitions for organizations. Competitions encourage camaraderie. Entire schools, businesses, and organizations compete against one another, providing individuals in these groups accountability and encouragement. During the competition period, all points earned while driving will go towards your competition total. Points can still be redeemed for treats during the competition without hurting your chances of winning! SAFE 2 SAVE works with administration, and advocates within an organization to coordinate and promote the competitions. In schools, we are proud to be an endorsed program by the Texas Association of Student Councils + FCCLA. SAFE 2 SAVE also partners with TxDOT + works closely with their team throughout the State of Texas.
What is the benefit of this partnership to the TASC organization as a whole, its member schools or individual advisors/students?	With the introduction of the smartphone, distracted driving has consistently risen as a cause for vehicle crashes year after year. TASC has the opportunity to encourage students, faculty, and parents to drive safely, save lives + save money when they utilize their points earned for rewards while doing so! With schools searching for ways to engage students, teachers, and faculty alike; SAFE 2 SAVE is the perfect way to encourage camaraderie and healthy competition while educating the school about an important cause simultaneously.

Describe the plan for serving schools across the state of Texas.	Through our research, we have found that engagement in competitions reduces distraction while driving by 25%. Students, Parents, Faculties, Organizations, + Employees compete in competitions providing camaraderie in support of and encouraging behavior change. Our mission is to change the attitude toward distracted driving by rewarding safe drivers. We strive to share this mission with schools across the nation and raise awareness about the growing epidemic of distracted driving. We will be reaching out to schools individuals encouraging them to host safe driving competitions.
